TISSUE GHOSTS

What you need:

Tissues, textra, string or ribbon

Take two tissues out of the box, ball one up and put it in the centre of the other tissue. Twist around the bottom of the balled tissue. Tie string below the head and let the bottom flow. Draw a face on with a textra and hang!



MONSTER TINS & MUMMY ROLLS

What you need:

Old tins, acrylic paint, pencils, craft eyes, textas.

Clean out the inside of some empty tins, soak off the labels and sand back any rough or sharp edges. Use some acrylic paint to paint a nice, even coat on the tin -- it might need a few layers. When dry, draw on the face outline in pencil and then fill in with black paint or textra and stick on eyes. And heelllllo monsters!



SPOOKY JARS

What you need:

Mason or old jars, battery tealight, black felt, coloured fabrics

Mason jars are super easy to decorate for Halloween! And you can use a little battery powered tea light in the bottom. You can cover them in any colour fabric you like, and make faces from black felt and stick them on to create a little monster army.
